Our Itinerary:

Day 01: Sunday, June 16: Departure from United States to Frankfurt Airport via scheduled airline.

Day 02: Monday, June 17: Arrival Airport Frankfurt – Schwarzach am Main Upon arrival at Frankfurt Airport we will be picked up by a modern motorcoach and we will meet Fritz, our tour escort who will accompany us throughout the tour. Afterwards we will be transferred to the Abbey of Münsterschwarzach for dinner and overnight. D



Day 03: Tuesday, June 18: Pommersfelden, Banz, Vierzeheiligen - Bamberg-Volkach After breakfast we will drive to the beautiful Pommersfelden Castle, where we will enjoy a guided tour of this former aristocratic house. After the visit we will

then visit the baroque Basilica of Vierzehenheiligen and then to Schloß Banz. On the way back to Münsterschwarzach, we will stop by the famous Bavarian town of Bamberg. Tonight will be a celebration as we enjoy dinner at the Kirch family winery in Volkach, then we return back to our accommodation in Münsterschwarzach. BD

Day 04: Wednesday, June 19: Rothenburg - Ulm

- Augsburg - St. Ottilien: Our next full day in Germany will take us south from Münsterschwarzach. The first stop today will be in the beautiful medieval town of Rothenburg ob der Tauber. You will see the famous townhall and St. James Church during a guided tour of the town.

Afterwards we will drive via Ulm and Augsburg, both of which we will visit, on our way to St. Ottilien. Tonight will be our first night's stay in the Abbey. BD



Day 05: Thursday, June 20: Ettal, Wieskirche,

Oberammergau & Tutzing: After our breakfast, we will drive towards the Alps for a visit of the Abbey of Ettal, where we will have Mass. After a lunchbreak in Oberammergau, we will travel to the very beautiful Wieskirche, the masterpiece of the great churchbuilder Dominikus Zimmerman. In the afternoon we will continue to Tutzing at Starnberg Lake, to visit the Benedictine Sisters' monastery. We will join the sisters for an evening meal and return to St. Ottilien for overnight. BD

Day 06: Friday, June 21: Garmisch - Innsbruck -

St. Johann: This morning we will leave St. Ottilien and start our journey to Austria. First we will enjoy a visit to the very picturesque town of Garmisch. Then we will enter the Austrian Tyrol and see the Olympic city of Innsbruck, then this afternoon we will continue further east and stay in St. Johann at the Hotel Sport Austria. BD

Day 07: Saturday, June 22: Salzburg:

After a short ride in our deluxe motorcoach, we will reach the city of Salzburg, where we will first visit St. Peter's Abbey for Mass. After a short walking tour through the Oldtown, we will enjoy lunch in the "Peterskeller"! There will be some free time before we leave Salzburg

Later this afternoon, we will travel back to our hotel in St. Johann for overnight. BD

Day 09: Monday, June 24; Monday, St. Johann -

Stams -Uznach - Einsiedeln: Enroute to Switzerland, we will visit the Cistercian Abbey of Stams, situated in the Tyrolean upper valley. Afterwards we will cross the Arlberg mountains and continue via Voralberg and Liechtenstein into Switzerland and the little village of Uznach to visit the abbey there for Mass and dinner and then we continue to our hotel in the Einsiedeln area. Day 10: Tuesday, June 25; Einsiedeln -

Pilatus -Lucerne - Lake of Constance After our morning mass in Einsiedeln, today's trip will take us into the heart of Switzerland to the well-known town of Lucerne, situated at the foot of Mount Pilatus and by the lake of the same name. After a trip up the mountain, there will be some time to explore the town and to walk across the famous Chapel Bridge. This afternoon we will continue to the area of Lake Constance, where we will be staying the next two nights. BD



Day 11: Wednesday, June 26; Reichenau Island -

Day 14: Saturday, June 29; St. Hildegard -

Rudesheim - Koblenz - Neuss This morning we will visit Hildegard von Bingen's Abbey, high over the Rhine River valley. After church, we will go back into the valley to enjoy a boat trip along the Rhine River to St. Goar. The banks along the river are studded with castles and ruins. We will also pass by the famous Loreley rock on our way. Then we will reboard our motorcoach and continue on via Bonn, to the town of Neuss for our final two nights in Germany. BD

Day 15: Sunday, June 30; Neuss - Cologne- Düsseldorf

On our final day in Germany, we will visit the special city of Cologne. After Mass, we will enjoy a tour of the Cologne cathedral. On the way back to Neuss, we will also stop in Düsseldorf for a stroll along Ko, the famous promenade, which is Düsseldorf's longest shopping street! This evening we will enjoy a farewell dinner together in a local brewery in Neuss! Overnight in Neuss hotel. BD
